### 3. Legal basis; purpose and scope of data processing

As part of your participation in the competition, we process the personal data you provide (in particular your name, email address, and, if applicable, membership number) in order to enable you to participate in the competition and to notify you if you win.

The legal basis for the processing is Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR (performance of a contract).

### 4. Right to object and right to erasure

The information provided by the participant to B&B Hotels in relation to the competition can be updated or deleted at any time at the participant's request.

To do so, an email must be sent to [datenschutz@hotelbb.com](mailto:datenschutz@hotelbb.com). The collection of the participant's data for the purpose of conducting the competition is essential for the implementation of the competition, which is why a request for deletion will result in exclusion from participation in the competition.

### 5. Data security

We take technical, contractual, and organizational measures to ensure the security of data processing in accordance with the state of the art. In doing so, we ensure that the provisions of data protection laws, in particular the General Data Protection Regulation, are complied with and that the data processed by us is protected against destruction, loss, alteration, and unauthorized access.

All information that you transmit to us is stored on our servers in the Federal Republic of Germany.

### 6. Disclosure of data to third parties

Data is only disclosed to third parties within the framework of legal requirements.

We only pass on user data to third parties if this is necessary, for example, on the basis of Art. 6 (1) lit. b) GDPR for contractual purposes or on the basis of

legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit. f) GDPR for the economic and effective operation of our business. Within the scope of order processing pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR, we use subcontractors for the provision of our services, in particular for the operation, maintenance, and hosting of IT systems. We have taken appropriate legal precautions and corresponding technical and organizational measures to ensure the protection of personal data in accordance with the relevant legal provisions.

## 7. Rights of participants

In the case of the processing of personal data, participants are data subjects within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and have the following rights vis-à-vis B&B Hotels

with regard to the personal data concerned:

- Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR)
- Right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR)
