PURCHASING POLICY

In accordance with our sustainable orientation, the availability of local or Slovenian suppliers is the first criteria of selection when purchasing items. The price, speed of delivery and available quantity are also important. We pay attention to the origin and the quality associated with it. If the item cannot be delivered, is not available in sufficient quantities and regularly or if the price is too high, we seek out other providers and distributors. This avoids the hindering of our process of operation.

We replace electronic devices with new energy-saving ones in cases when repairs are not financially feasible or possible. When buying electronic devices, the price, energy efficiency and quality of the device are taken into account. Electronic devices are regularly serviced to avoid malfunctions.

We keep a record of cleaning agents and disinfectants, which are purchased as needed. We also control the used quantity and make sure that the consumption is rational.

When purchasing or when choosing a supplier, we look for and choose as a priority:

1. Products from recycled material or recyclable products. Reduce/reuse/recycle are our guiding principles in purchasing and we use them in communication with guests, partners and suppliers. For each new purchase, we check whether there is a product made of recycled or recyclable material. All glass jars from food are stored for decorative purposes.

We already removed plastic water bottles, water storage tanks and cups from the hotel. We also replaced the ballpoint pens in the rooms with ordinary wooden pencils. Hard soaps and shampoos in plastic packaging in guest rooms were replaced with dispensing containers. We use recycled toilet paper and more and more recycled paper for daily business.

We switched to a smaller paper format of printed invoices, namely from A4 to A5, to reduce paper consumption. Glass jars (jams, pickled items ...) are recycled and reused for decoration.

2. Supply/delivery with less packaging

In so far as possible, we buy larger packaging, so that a minimum quantity of waste material and packaging is discarded. In addition, we also select suppliers who offer reusable packaging (fruit/vegetable crates, etc.)

3. Energy efficiency.

When buying electronic devices, the price, energy efficiency and quality of the device are taken into account.

We replace electronic devices with new energy-saving ones in cases when repairs are not financially feasible or possible.

4. Fair trade/local/organic

We obtain homemade honey from our beehives that we keep on the roof.

We use homemade honey and other products from local providers made from natural materials and recycled materials as business gifts.

We choose local food suppliers first. When purchasing food, the restaurant gives preference to organically grown food.

We plant herbs on the roof and use them in the kitchen on a daily basis.

During the COVID pandemic, health and safety of our guests comes first. Purchasing takes place in accordance with the guidelines, recommendations and adopted measures.
